Who We Share Your Data With

We may share your information with:

- Group Companies We may share your data with our affiliated companies where necessary.
- **Service Providers** We may use third-party service providers to manage certain business functions (e.g., email marketing or website analytics), but your data will only be processed as instructed by us and protected under contract.
- **Regulatory Authorities** On rare occasions, we may be required to share your information with regulators or authorities, for example, to respond to a legal request or investigation.

Your Rights

Under UK data protection law, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- **Right to Be Informed** We must inform you clearly about what data we collect, why we collect it, how long we retain it, and who we share it with.
- **Right of Access** You can request access to your personal data, and we will provide it free of charge unless the request is excessive or repetitive.
- **Right to Rectification** You can ask us to correct any inaccurate or incomplete information we hold about you.
- Right to Erasure Under certain circumstances, you can request that we delete your
 personal data. We will comply unless we are legally required to retain it (e.g., for paying
 suppliers).
- **Right to Object** You can object to the processing of your data if it is based on legitimate interest or direct marketing purposes.
- **Rights Relating to Automated Decision**-Making You have the right not to be subject to decisions made solely by automated processes that significantly affect you. We do not use such processes.
